CHICAGO, III., May, 1868

After being in Chicago a month, I rill endeavor to describe to your read-ins a few of the most important buildings of the World's Columbian exposi-tion. The first one, and one that I am nest requested with, is the

DEPARTMENT OF HORIZCULTURE.

It takes up about eleven acres of ground. The part that is used for flori culture comprises a dome which is 125 feet high by 200 feet wide, and there is a wing on each side of the dome, each one of which is 400 feet long, 100 feet wide, and sixty feet high. A person will see plants and flowers in this building from all over the world. Palms of every variety. Fern-of all kinds—nome tree ferns fifteen feet high. Rubber trees, orange and lemon trees, ban ann trees, fig trees, coffee trees, cactue of all kinds, and a thousand of other varieties of tropical plants that would take up a whole newspaper to name them. There is a mountain built in the center of the dome, which is a wooden structure and terraced. It is rooden structure and terraced. It is overed with all kinds of tropical fruits. ere is a crystal cave in the mountain, and the crystals are brought from the Mammoth crystal cave in South Office in Breyman Bros. Building akota. It is a fac-simile of that cave, here are two large buildings in this spartment where fresh and canned uits are exhibited. In the California artment is a large monument of ages and lemons. It is a lovely sight. Oregon has also a fine display of fresh and canned fruits. There are everal large green-houses in this de-partment. A person will see some of the choicest flowers here that can be osen anywhere. There are thousands of people visit this department every day, and they are completely infatu-ated with it. At one side of the dome is a beautiful model of the United States capitol. It is made of cape flowers. The grounds are all laid off into little flower beds with walks all through them. THE MANUPACTURER'S BUILDING.

This is the largest building on the grounds—covers forty acres of ground and is 250 feet high. All the exhibits are not unpacked yet, but, as it is, a person can spend a day very profitably looking at the different things that are manufactured all over the world. 


