FREE TRADE WAGES.

Very many men in these United States do not realize that there is a vast difference in the wages here and in other countries.

The first column gives an average wage rate per month in America, the other in a country where labor is not protected:

Table with columns: OCCUPATION, PROTECTED FREE, and another column with wage rates for various professions like Bakers, Barbers, Blacksmiths, etc.

When we open our ports to the products of the world, we come in direct competition with the labor on the scale of wages given above.

Out of the above wages the laborer supports himself and wife and children. Of course it is impossible for him to save anything, but if he does not work he starves.
