Mr. Ingram became a Mason at the age of 21 and for many years was a member of the local lodge of A. F. & A. M.

His early life was spent under the influence of the M. E. church and he was always a liberal supporter of the church and its benevolences.

Mr. Ingram was a kind hearted man, always willing to do what he could for those who needed help. No task too hard, no burden too great for him to undertake if he might help somebody. During the last few weeks of his life he made his peace with God and his end was triumphant.

He leaves to mourn his loss his beloved wife and companion of all the years of their married life, and three brothers and a host of friends. Mrs. Ingram has the sympathy of a host of friends in her bereavement.

The funeral services were held at the M. E. church, Rev. F. S. Climo preaching the sermon.

GLACIER IS MAKING RECORD

That at Grindelwald, Switzerland, So to Be Moving at a Pace That Is Phenomenal.

A strange Alpine phenomenon is taking place at Grindelwald, that mountain center much beloved by tourists of all nationalities, both in summer and winter, with its little town clustering under great range of white mountains. Many who have stood on the famous Grindelwald glacier have been unconscious that they were moving, for the action of the ice as it pushes toward the valley is so slow as to be imperceptible—an ordinary pace for a glacier often being a few yards in 50 years. But the Grindelwald glacier has been moving at the rate of four feet to six feet a day for over a week. It has already obliterated a pine forest and a stone bridge across the Black Latchine, as the ice river makes its way across the water to the upper banks. It is thought the rapid movement is due to the enormous amount of snow and ice on the higher portions of the glacier pressing it downward; but visitors and those making observations are watching with interest, and realizing that what would have taken a thousand years to do gradually is being accomplished before their eyes at topspeed.—Christian Science Monitor.

CURRENCY INFLATION.

The paper currency of 30 principal countries of the world at the beginning of the war aggregated a little over \$7,000,000,000. At the end of the war, November, 1918, it was \$40,000,000,000, and in December, 1919, it totaled \$51,000,000,000, these figures being in round terms and exclusive of the currency issues of the bolshevik government, which alone are estimated at \$34,000,000,000.
