## IN EXPLANATION TO PROSPECTORS

Editor POST Jacksonville Oregon,  
Dear Sir:—

Having been in public life so long in Mexico, I am deluged with letters from Americans, regarding the proposed Anti-foreign mining law, and among them find inquiries from several people in your County, therefore will kindly ask you to publish an article setting forth the true facts for the benefit of your readers.

The bill will not pass because the Mexican Cabinet know full well President Diaz would veto a bill so unjust to Americans, who have millions in the Mexican Mines.

The Minister of Fomento, the chief instigator of the bill has resigned from the Mexican Cabinet, because of the friction, which the proposed bill engendered between himself and President Diaz. The President and the better class of Mexicans, value too highly the friendship of the Americans to jeopardize the holdings of U. S. citizens.

In fact there is no country in the civilized world, in which better protection is afforded to law abiding foreigners. This fact has been demonstrated by a large number of Americans, who have accumulated fortunes during the past 25-years in Mexican gold mines.

### ALASKA-YUKON-PACIFIC

(Special Correspondence.)

The sale of \$350,000 worth of ex-position bonds has removed the last obstacle to the success of the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific exposition and it is now certain that the 1909 fair will have the distinction of being the first big exposition to be entirely completed in time for the opening date. The progress that is being made on the construction of the buildings and grounds is a guarantee that no detail will be left unfinished when the fair is formally opened June 1, 1909.

When it was announced that an additional \$350,000 was required to carry on the work outlined by the exposition management the people of Seattle responded promptly to the call for funds and the entire amount was subscribed within a week after the actual canvass was commenced. With this additional fund on hand the management of the exposition took immediate steps to enlarge the scope of construction.

Already three of the permanent buildings are finished and are ready to be turned over to the University of Washington at the close of the fair. By the first of the new year the fourth permanent building will be completed and a number of the temporary structures finished. The mining palace and the fisheries building and the hospital and fire station are in use and the Oregon building, the first state building to be completed, is ready to receive exhibits. Oregon will begin the ship-
