### AS TO CLIMATIC CONDITIONS.

We have a climate not excelled anywhere, neither too hot in summer or too cold in winter, but just the temperature most conducive to health, in addition to which the rainfall is never excessive, neither do we suffer from drouth as do some other less favored regions. Situated as we are between arms of the foothills, the soil receives moisture through sub-irrigation, sufficient to keep vegetation growing luxuriantly during the summer months, the richness of the soil, in connection with the proper climatic conditions making this valley an ideal spot for the fruit-grower and gardener.

Not very many years ago the U. S. Patent Office, refused to grant a patent for, or consider "anything so foolish as a flying machine."
