THE TAX LEVY

For 1910 Amounts to More Than Half a Million Dollars. Now Payable at Sheriff's Office.

The tax list is now completed and has been turned over to the sheriff's office for collection. The total amount of taxes to be collected is \$517,374.49 divided among the various funds as follows: State and County \$219,083.67; Special School \$153,359.17; Roads and Highways \$48,487.36; Special City Tax \$99,453.23.
