To Purify Water.

To purify water sprinkle a tablespoonful of pulverized alum into a hogshead of water (the water to be stirred at the same time). It will after a few hours, by precipitating to the bottom the impure particles, so purify the water that it will be found to contain nearly all the freshness and clearness of spring water. A pailful containing four gallons may be purified by a teaspoonful of alum.--National Magazine.
