## Special Taxes Upon Druggists.

Washington, Feb. 27.—Physicians, dentists, druggists and manufacturers or dealers who sell or administer narcotic drugs are required under the new revenue bill to register and pay license taxes to revenue collectors within the next 10 days. This amendment of the Harrison narcotic drug act also taxes opium, cocaine and derivatives or medicines containing these, at the normal rate of one cent an ounce, and makes it illegal to sell drugs not bearing revenue stamps.

Manufacturers, importers and wholesalers hereafter will be compelled to make monthly reports. These new legal provisions are regarded as police measures by which revenue officers hope to wage a much stronger fight against narcotics.

## AUTO LICENSE FEES RAISED.

Increases of \$5 to \$11 Over Previous Schedule.

Salem, Or., Feb. 27.—The roads and highways committee at a meeting last night reached a final decision upon the schedule license fees to be assessed against motor vehicles for the next two years as part of the road-building program. In the fees for automobile proper, house bill 515 was amended last night by making increases ranging from \$5 to \$11 for the different types of cars.

Provision is made that on cars registered on or after July 1 of any year but one half of the fees shall be paid, and for cars registered on or after October 1 but one-fourth shall be paid.

The bill eliminates the property tax on motor vehicles and requires instead that the secretary of state turn back to the counties one-fourth of the amount collected in fees. It is believed that the amendments made by the committee last night will prove entirely satisfactory when the bill comes up for final action today, and that there will be further debate. The schedule on motorcycles and motor cars follows:

Motor bicycles, \$3; motorcycles, \$6; electric pleasure vehicles, \$18; electric service vehicles, under one ton capacity \$25; all steam, gasoline and hydrocarbon operated vehicles (except motor trucks having a rated maximum load-carrying capacity one ton and over, up to and including 23-horsepower), \$15; in excess of 23 horsepower and inclusive of 26 horsepower, \$21; in excess of 26 horsepower and inclusive of 30 horsepower, \$27; in excess of 30 and inclusive of 36 horsepower, \$34; in excess of 36 and inclusive of 40 horsepower, \$36; in excess of 40 horsepower, \$41.

Following is the schedule of rates for trucks:

One ton and not over 1 1/2 tons, \$32; over 1 1/2 and not over 2 tons, \$48; over 2 tons and not over 2 1/2 tons, \$60; over 2 1/2 tons and not over 3 tons, \$72; over 3 tons and not over 3 1/2 tons, \$84; over 3 1/2 tons and not over 4 tons, \$96; over 4 tons and not over 4 1/2 tons, \$108; over 4 1/2 tons and not over 5 tons, \$120.

Portland, Or., Feb. 25.—Ella Bruce, aged 32, was arrested by Sergeant Young and Patrolmen Abbott and Drake this morning at the Union station and is held on a federal charge of violating the Reed prohibition amendment. Carrying 14 quarts of liquor in a suit case, she was arrested as she stepped from a California train.

## State Aid Bill Referred.

In a considerably amended form so as to eliminate limited service men who did not go over seas and members of the student's army corps, the bill by Senators Pierce and Smith of Coos providing for state aid in educating soldiers, sailors and marines passed the house today and will be referred to the people at the special election.

This bill gives \$200 a year to such soldiers for four years. The bill

## Auto Examiners Created.

Salem, Or., Feb. 27.—A board of examiners for auto mechanics is provided for among the bills finally passed by the legislature today with the names of Senator Shanks and Representative Stewart attached.

Under the bill the governor is to appoint a board of three examiners, who will examine all auto mechanics and issue licenses for a fee of \$5 a year. Examinations will be held at least quarterly at Portland, Eugene, Astoria, La Grande and Klamath Falls, notice of examinations to be posted on the county courts' bulletin board. Examiners will receive \$10 a day and expenses while actually employed.

Mr. Stewart states there was a demand for this legislation from mechanics and garage men as well.
