### High School.

Supt. of Public Instruction, J. A. Churchill, has recently written a very interesting letter to about 300 boys and girls of Jackson County who completed the eight grade during the last year, urging them to continue their education by entering some standard high school

this fall.

In commenting upon the value of an education, Mr. Churchill refers to the book entitled "Who's Who in America" which contains the names of men and women who have obtained national prominence in some line of endeavor, and of the interesting conclusion reached by an investigator who carefully examined the issue of 1917. This is the inference drawn: The child with no schooling has one chance in 15,000 of performing distinguished service; with

an eight grade preparation, he has four times the chance; with a high school education, 87 times the chance; with a college education 800 times the chance.

Every boy and girl has a desire to fill the most honorable place which his ability will permit, but not all realize that their success depends upon the preparation they make to enable them to take advantage of the many opportunities open only to those who are trained.
