Two years ago this week the present owners took charge of the Post. Since that time numerous changes for the betterment of the town and community have taken place. Among these are—the town has almost doubled in population; real estate values and rents have also doubled, and in many cases tripled; more real estate deals have been made here during the last two years than for 20 or 30 years prior to that time; more paint has been used and more cleaning up and general improvements made than for many years before. Were houses to be had here no doubt the population would now be nearer the 2000 mark than half that number. The Post is too modest to claim any credit for this welcome change, but many of our readers are kind and liberal enough to give this paper a portion of the credit for helping to bring about this most desirable change in conditions here.

Good news for the lumber manufacturers of Jackson county was contained in a recent announcement by the Southern Pacific that, beginning Oct. 31, Medford will have the same rate to Southern California points as has Klamath Falls, Weed and other competing points to the east and south. The new rate from Medford to Los Angeles will be 43c, instead of 65c, and to San Francisco 23c instead of 39c. This reduction in rates may encourage another mill or two to go in at Jacksonville—the best sawmill site in Oregon.

The open season for hunting pheasant and quail will open Sunday, 14th, and end the third Sunday in October—the 21st. The deer hunting season, which opened Sept. 10, will end the last day of this month. The season for ducks and geese, which began Oct. 1st, will last until Jan. 15th.

The grand jury will convene next Monday, 15th, and the regular October term of circuit court will begin a week later—on October 22. The criminal docket this time is unusually short, but the usual long string of civil cases will come up for hearing.
