

A method of covering cotton with silk has been devised. The silk is dissolved in hydrochloric acid, or an ammoniacal solution of copper or nickel. Water is added until the solution begins to cloud, when the cotton, previously mordanted, is immersed in it for a few minutes. When taken out, it will be found to be plated with silk.
