A very strong prejudice is existing there against Portland merchants, and the sooner this prejudice is removed the better it will be for them, and for this purpose we hereby open our columns to the discussion of the difficulty, and invite correspondents from those localities to answer our question, 'Eastern Oregon and Washington, what can we do for you?'"

The editor of THE WEST SHORE appreciates the situation, and he gives good advice. One thing Portland can do for Eastern Oregon is to use her influence to obtain appropriations for the immediate construction of the canal and locks at the Cascades. The people of this section are in real earnest about this great work; and they want no tampering, no temporizing policy inaugurated.
