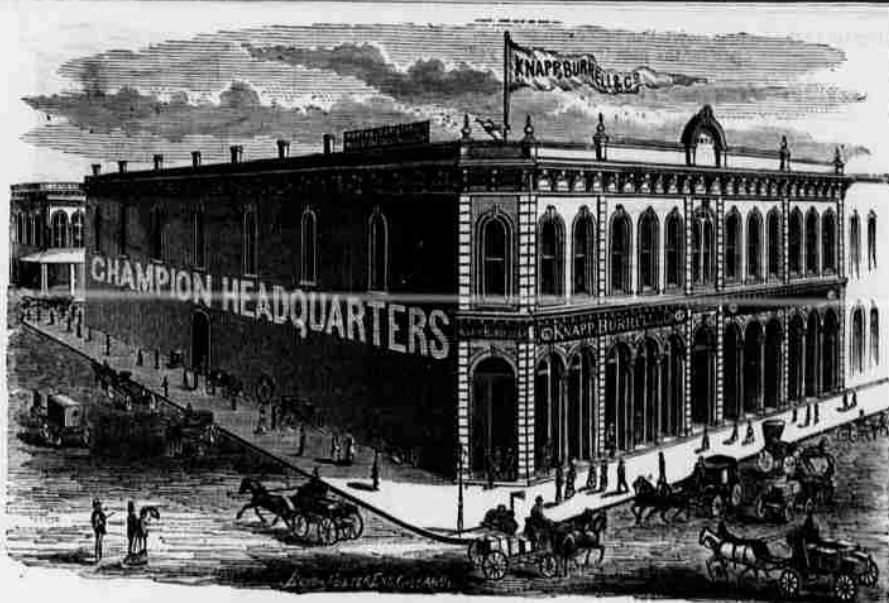


VERY many of the early settlers of Oregon and Washington Territory plowed up their ground with a wooden implement shod with iron, seeded the same broadcast, and covered it with a wooden-toothed harrow, or a small oak tree-top, gathered the grain with a hand-sickle or reap-hook, threshed it out with a Cayuse threshing machine, which run on four legs, and finally made it ready for bread by crushing in a mortar.
