VERY many of the early settlers of regon and Washington Territory Oregon plowed up their ground with a worden implement shod with iron, seeded the same broadcast, and covered it with a wooden-toothed harrow, or a small oak tree-top, gathered the grain with a handsickle or reap-hook, threshed it out with a Cayuse threshing machine, which run on four legs, and finally sickle or made it ready for bread by crushing in a mortar. Now-a-days we do things differently. 
