THE DALLES

THE DALLES

Is situated on the Columbia river, 105 miles northeast of Portland; has a population of about 1000, has good schools, an academy in charge of the Sisters, several neat churches, weekly newspaper, and numerous business houses, of a substantial character. A line of steamers make daily trips from here to the Cascades, there connecting with railroad and steamers for Portland. It is on this line that most of the far-famed Oregon scenery can be viewed. A line of mail stages start from here daily for all the Eastern Oregon mining towns, making various connections at different points, and finally run through Itaho to Kelton, on the Central Pacific railroad. The trip from The Dalles to Kelton is made in five days. A railroad of fifteen miles in length connects The Dalles with Ceilio, from whence a tri-weekly line of elegant steamers make regular trips to Umatilla, Wallula, and in the Summer season to Lewiston, in Idaho Territory. From Wallula at line of railroad makes daily trips to Walla Walla, W. T., and from thence daily stages to Waitsburg, Dayton and Lewiston. It will thus be seen what an important position The Dalles occupies. It is really the toil-gate where all travellers and all freight for any of the above mentioned places must pay a toll. With the building of the locks at the Cascades, The Dalles will commence growing, and the day is not far distant when it will be a city of from 4,000 to 5,000 inhabitants.


STOCK KANING

Forty thousand head went to the Eastern States last Spring and 25,000 to California via Winnenneca by railroad. The local trade is with Scattle, Olympia and Victoria, In Astoria they are contracted for by the 1000 head for canning purposes, to be shipped to Liverpool and other English markets. The people of Oregon can put those cattle on the market at one and a half cents gross weight. In Umatilla county to-day there are not less than 1,250,000 sheep. All these immense herds of cattle and sheep get their living out of doors the year round, with few exceptions. The agricultural resources of Eastern Oregon are unequaled. The fruit in this locality is equal in quantity and quality to the products of any other State in the Union.
