WASHINGTON.

Ellensburg, the county seat of Kittitas county, is a town that takes its growth from four years ago. Its population is about 1,000, half of whom were here the year before. Its resources are, first, agricultural, second, stock, the tributary ranges now feeding 100,000 head. Its minerals well developed are gold, silver, copper, iron, marble, but the greatest by far is gravel quantities, all kinds, are quarried from 40 to 80 per cent.  
Kittitas county is the geographical center of Washington. The valley is the center of the county, the town the center of the valley. There are abundant resources to support a large town. The enclosed table is that the population will equal 25,000 in a few years. Property has doubled in value annually, and investments made now will bring four-fold returns. (7/10/11)

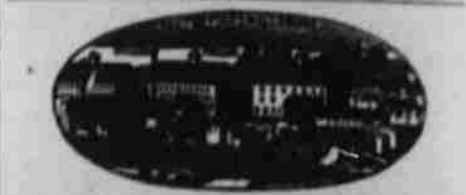
