

INTERNATIONAL TRADE.



The number of American vessels which entered this port during the same quarter was 215, representing a tonnage of 170,440 tons. The number of vessels which left was 214.

The Coos Bay & Eastern railway company has been organized at Marshfield, Oregon, and will next week have men in the field surveying a line from that town up the Coos river and across the Coast mountains to Winchester, a town near the Southern Pacific about six miles north of Roseburg. The design is to ultimately extend the road to Boise City, Idaho, but the present operations look only to giving rail communication to the Coos bay country.
