The Video documentary **In Our Name: The Bombing in El Salvador** will be aired on local Portland Cable Access Station 7 on April 7th at 1:30 p.m. and April 26th at 7:00 p.m. **In Our Name** was produced by the Committee in Solidarity with the People of El Salvador as part of their National Campaign to Stop the Bombing in El Salvador. The main focus of the video is an interview with Dr. Charles Clements, an American who spent a year working as a civilian doctor in rebel-held territory of El Salvador. Dr. Clements is author of the book **Witness to War**, an account of his experiences in El Salvador.
