Out of the forty films offered, **Just Out** especially suggests: **Hannah and Her Sisters** (USA), February 20 at the Fox Theatre, 8:30 p.m.; **Sotto, Sotto** (Italy), February 28 at the NWFVC, 7 p.m.; **Ronnia, The Robber's Daughter** (Sweden), February 21 at KOIN Center, 7:00 p.m.

Colonel Redl, a film about Alfred Redl, a high-ranking military commander of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, details his mystery-shrouded suicide in Vienna in 1913. Redl's suicide prompted rumors of treason, espionage, blackmail, and sexual duplicity at a time when the political and cultural tensions within the Empire were setting the stage for the cataclysm of World War I.
