Views expressed in letters to the editor, columns, and features may not be those of the editorial staff of Just Out.



Since July, 1984, Just Out has been printed by Outlook Publishing Company, Gresham, Oregon. The issue now in your hands is the last to be printed there.

Two days before our reserved printing date, we learned that Outlook Publishing Company would no longer print *Just Out*. The reason given was that the printing plant manager objected to printing *Just Out* because of his "religious beliefs."

Ironically, this is the second time Just Out has had to find a new printer because of homophobia. We went to Outlook Publishing becuse Crawford Publishing (Nickel Ads) had refused our business due to the "personal reason" of the company owner. The personal

reason, we later learned, was homophobia, of course.

Police Liaison reaffirmed

Chief James Davis of the Portland Police Bureau has reaffirmed Captain Tom Potter as the Police Liaison to the lesbian/gay community, reports Sid Galton, member of the Metropolitan Human Relations Commission, and newly-appointed Chair of the Citizen's Advisory Committee of Central Precinct.

In the letter announcing the decision, the new Chief stated, "I agree with Captain Bob Tobin [who was acting Chief] that it is beneficial to keep Captain Potter in the position to

guarantee continuity and effectiveness." Captain Potter of Central Precinct was named Police Liaison last year by former

Chief Penny Harrington.
