### Rest area busts increasing

ctivity at the Baldock Rest Area on I-5 south of Charbonneau has led to the arrest of several men during recent months. Some of those arrested have already been convicted of Public Indecency while others are still awaiting trial.

Information indicates that the men have been arrested at their homes by police from Clackamas County. They are shown photographs of themselves, then taken into custody. One man says he was shown a photograph of himself while sitting in a stall and another while he was getting into his car.

Ben Merrill, a Portland attorney who has represented two of the men, says, "So far, those who plead guilty to "Public Indecency" are being sentenced to one year bench probation, a fine of \$100 and up to sixty hours of community service in lieu of jail.


