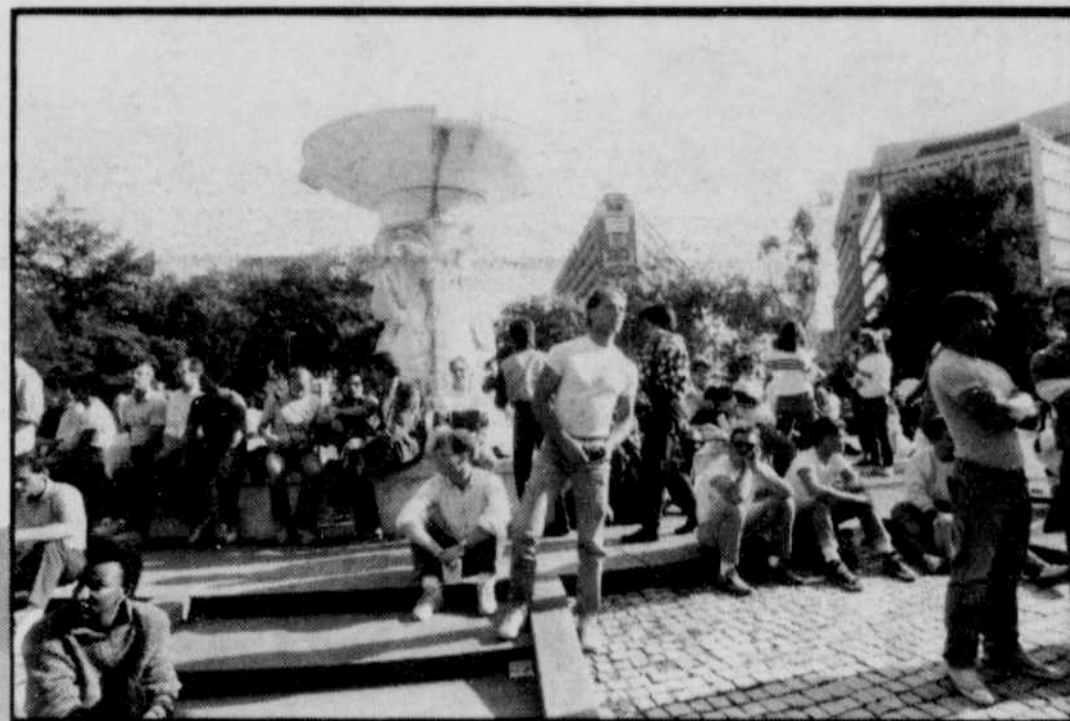


# WASHINGTON, D.C. OCTOBER, 1987 A CAPITOL STATEMENT
