



**Gretchen Kafoury receives human rights award**

**M**ultnomah County Commissioner Gretchen Kafoury was presented with the Russell A. Peyton Human Relations Award at the Metropolitan Human Relations Award ceremony on January 15. Congratulating Commissioner Kafoury is MHRC member Sid Galton.

The Peyton Award, named for the first

executive director of MHRC, is presented to an individual who makes outstanding achievements in the areas of human and civil rights. Commissioner Kafoury's main concerns are focused on minority and low-income issues. Her concerns also include divestment in South Africa, women's and gay rights, and peace issues. She is also the founder of Oregon's Women's Political Caucus and was the first lobbyist for the Women's Rights Coalition.
