**AIDS-Helpline** is a 24-hour AIDS information switchboard providing peer counseling, information and referrals. (672-3000.)


**Douglas County Gay Archives** is a repository for materials relevant to the rural homophile. (PO Box 942, Dillard, OR 97432, 679-9144.)
