





The Stonewall Rebellion's twentieth anniversary

Conewall — Twenty Years, A Generation of Pride, the national theme of Lesbian and Gay Pride 1989, will characterize celebrations from coast to coast during the month of June. The annual celebrations commemorate a rebellion against a routine police raid at a gay bar in Greenwich Village on the weekend of June 27-29, 1969.

The following is excepted from The Alyson Almanac's account of the rebellion:

Early in the morning of June 28, a routine police raid on the Stonewall Bar at 53 Christopher Street, in New York City, turned into a riot when the patrons put up unexpected resistance. A group of uniformed policemen arrived at the bar about 3 a.m. They ordered customers to leave, then began arresting employees, as well as several drag queens. Although such arrests had often taken place without protest,

this time the crowd began to react. They began chanting "Pigs!" at the police, then threw bottles. The police barricaded themselves inside the bar, which itself came under attack from the crowd. According to one observer, the riot was escalating and the trapped police were about to begin firing on the crowd when reinforcements arrived, and the group dispersed. Further riots continued, for the next several evenings."

Events commemorating the rebellion began the following year in the coastal metropolises. Today the rebellion is celebrated in hundreds of cities worldwide.

On June 17, in Portland, Grand Marshalls Howie Baggadonutz, Judy Tallwing McCarthey. Tom Norton, and Cathy Siemens will lead the parade from the North Park Blocks along Broadway and end up at Tom McCall Waterfront Park. The parade begins at noon at NW Couch and Park. The Rally at Waterfront Park continues until 6 p.m. at the stage near the Battleship Oregon memorial. Everyone is invited - more than 5,000 people participated in the event last year in Portland.

n June 30, 1986, the United States Supreme Court ruled that gays and lesbians have no right to engage in same-sex relations in the privacy of a bedroom (or anywhere else) under the United States Constitution. Justice Byron White wrote the majority opinion

in Bowers v. Hardwick: Justices Rehnquist. Powell, O'Connor and Berger joined. Justices Blackmun, Marshall, Brennan and Stevens dissented.

The Court concluded that the belief that homosexual sodomy is immoral and unacceptable provided an adequate rationale, and that the decision dealt exclusively with homosexual sodomy despite the fact that the Georgia statute in question applied equally to all persons regardless of their sexual preference or marital

In his dissenting opinion, Justice Blackmun wrote, "That certain, but by no means all, religious groups condemn the behavior at issue gives the state no license to impose their judgments on the entire citizenry. The legitimacy of secular legislation depends instead on whether the State can advance some justification for its law beyond its conformity to religious doctrine."

Gays and lesbians across the United States will join together, on June 30, 1989, in the spirit of Justice Blackmun's dissent, to protest the Supreme Court's decision in Bowers v. Hardwick and its adherence to religious persecution. In Portland, lesbians and gays will be present at the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth District (Pioneer Courthouse) for a day of mourning for our right to love whom we choose.

The presence will begin at 8 a.m. and continue until 5 p.m. with a rally at noon in Pioneer Courthouse Square. A planning meeting for the demonstration will be held on June 6, at 6 p.m., in City Hall Room 402. for information or to volunteer, call 224-1976.
