

Kearns returns in "Intimacies"

Michael Kearns, gay actor and activist, will return to Portland for two performances of "Intimacies," his newest and most critically acclaimed work. "Intimacies," a

gripping solo piece, takes a walk on the wild side with six people with AIDS: Denny, a former disco bunny who is a mental and

physical wreck; a black street prostitute named Big Red whose baby was born with and is dying of AIDS; 19-year-old Rusty, a street hustler/speed freak who is confused about his sexuality; perfect Patrick, an accountant at Disney Studios; middle-class Mary, infected with the virus through a blood transfusion; and Phoenix, a homeless 63-year-old ex-con and drug abuser.

During the past decade, Michael Kearns has built a solid reputation as an actor with a determined sense of purpose. With "Intimacies," he moves beyond his reputation of Mr. Gay Theatre and takes the epidemic out of the confines of the middle-class white gay milieu. With only a stool and a scarf for props, Kearns has nothing more than his voice, body movement, and facial expressions

to get the very different personalities across. Said Daily Variety, "Kearns offers the furnace of drama: sharp, poignant characters. His people are utterly human, and their plight is a tragedy."

Kearns was recently presented with a proclamation from the city of Los Angeles which recognizes his dedication to bringing an understanding of AIDS.

Kearns will perform "Intimacies" in the Great Hall, Westminster Presbyterian Church, 1624 NE Hancock, on Friday and Saturday, January 26 and 27 at 8 pm. Tickets are \$10 in advance from A Woman's Place Bookstore, Music Millennium and the Cascade AIDS Project; or \$12 at the door. A portion of the proceeds will benefit the Cascade AIDS Project.
