Two Nice Girls and comic Renee Hicks combine talents in concert Dec. 8, 8 pm, at the Northwest Service Center, 1819 NW Everett. Part of the vanguard of "out" lesbians recording on mainstream labels, Two Nice Girls is four women who sing and play in what could be called a folk-disco-country-rock-and-roll band. Hailing from Austin, Texas, Two Nice Girls have released two albums on the Rough Trade label. Yes, this is women's music with a definite edge. Rocket magazine has called them the first great dyke cover band of the 90's because of their album *Like a Version* which features songs by the Carpenters, Bad Company and Donna Summer. Probably best known for their song "I Spent My

Last Ten Dollars on Birth Control and Beer" Two Nice Girls combine humor, spell-binding harmonies and powerful instrumental work on all their songs. With Gretchen Philips and Kathy Korniloff on guitars, Pam Barger on drums and ex-Portland musician Meg Hentges (of Neo-Boys fame) on bass, Two Nice Girls will keep you tapping your feet and singing along all night long.

Opening the show will be San Francisco comedienne Renee Hicks. Renee is a bold, black, bald-headed woman who has become a favorite at all the national women's festivals. Renee derives most of her material from everyday life, her family, newspapers, current events and her creative mind. She used to be an accountant but now is making her living from stand-up comedy work. Be prepared to laugh loud and long with Renee Hicks. 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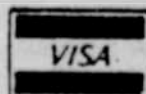


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
