CALIFORNIA

In an unprecedented move, the Los Angeles

Unified School District sanctioned a prom for gay and lesbian students of the district. According to the Associated Press, about 200 students attended the event, which was held at the Los Angeles Hilton and

Towers. The theme of the prom was "Live to Tell."

COLORADO

The Radisson Hotel in Denver will be the site of the 1994 "Out and Equal in the '90s," a conference on workplace issues affecting the gay, lesbian and bisexual communities. The theme, "Working It Out in the Rockies," reflects the educational and motivational aspects of the conference. Planned for Oct. 15 and 16, sessions will cover workplace issues for corporations, small businesses, labor unions, public employment and nonprofits. Topics will include empowerment in government employment; having HIV and a career; and unlearning racism, sexism and classism in the workplace. A one-day institute for human resource professionals will be held Oct. 17.

DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

The U.S. House of Representatives will hold hearings in September to consider adding sexual orientation and religion to the mandate of the Department of Justice's Community Relations Service. CRS is a mediation agency. In March it was involved in the Camp Sister Spirit case in Ovett, Miss., at the urging of the National Gay and Lesbian Task Force. However, its limited mandate has kept CRS from responding to a number of community disputes that could benefit from federal mediation.


