was very exclusive. You know, that it was focused on gay white male businessmen. The criticisms ultimately prompted the committee to pull out of the event just two weeks before it was supposed to be held. Many people feared there would be no Gay Pride because of that controversy, but PTC stepped in and took over. Gay Pride went on, but not without creating some bad feelings," he says.

Prompted by the controversy, some gay men and lesbians form a group called TKO (short for technical knockout), whose goal is to build a bridge between their respective communities.

1982

has predominantly been just that-gay male pride. For the first time, due largely to interim work by TKO, lesbians and gay men from various cultural and economic backgrounds really get involved in


