



## **REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

The Oregon Health Division announces the availability of funds to develop, design and print a quarterly health newsletter targeting gay/bisexual men. The purpose of the newsletter is to present information, resources, and contacts to increase the likelihood that gay men will choose to adopt and maintain behaviors to reduce the risk of HIV infection. Applicants for awards will be non-profit, community-based organizations (CBO's) with a primary role of HIV prevention and significant interaction in the gay/bisexual male community.

A total of \$15,560 is available for one CBO to publish the newsletter for a twelve month period begin-ning approximately December 1, 1995. 


