

The National Association of People with AIDS (NAPWA) has launched an education and prevention program to provide information about HIV-related cytomegalovirus (CMV) disease for health care providers and people living with HIV disease.

As part of the program, a confidential 24-hour toll-free "CMV Prevention Hotline," will operate until June 14, 1996.

CMV can cause serious sightthreatening and/or lifethreatening illness in individuals with compromised immune systems. Approximately 40 percent of people with HIV disease develop CMV retinitis. NAPWA's CMV education and

prevention program is being supported by a grant from Roche Laboratories.
