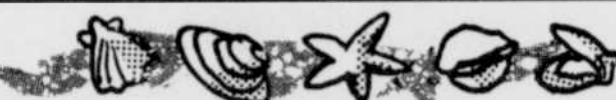

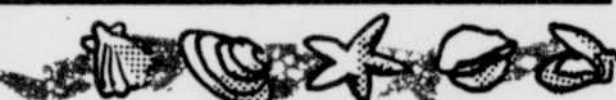

The Gay Health Advisory Committee (GHAC) to the Oregon Health Division is currently accepting applications for membership positions.

GHAC's mission is to advocate for, maintain, promote and improve the physical and psychosocial health and well being of gay and bisexual men and other men who have sex with men (MSM) in the state of Oregon.

Oregonians who reflect the geographic, racial, ethnic and age diversity within the gay, bisexual and MSM populations are encouraged to apply. Though primarily focused on HIV prevention issues, GHAC has been discussing other gay health issues, such as alcohol and drug abuse, domestic violence, sexual abuse, and sexually transmitted diseases.

Applications must be completed and received at the Oregon Health Division no later than July 3, 1998. Upon review and acceptance by GHAC, new members will be notified by telephone on July 10, 1998. New members must attend a GHAC orientation and meeting in Bend, Oregon, on July 17, 18 and 19. The Oregon Health Division will provide meals, lodging and mileage reimbursement for GHAC members to attend quarterly meetings.
