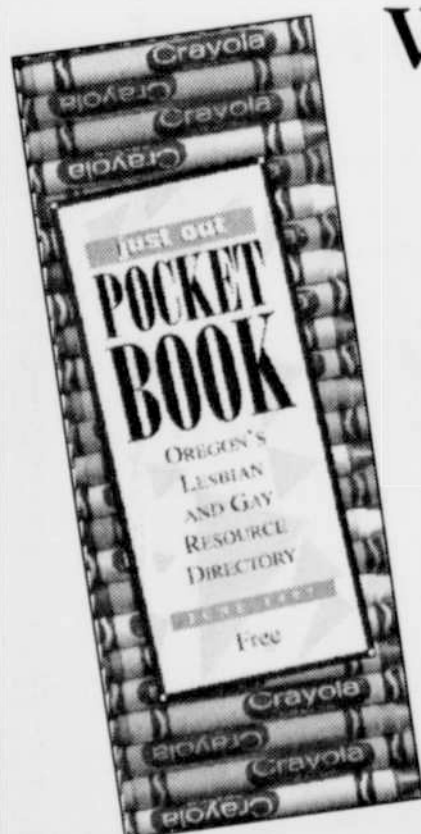


Donna Redwing

**S**ince 1996, Donna Red Wing has been National Field Director of the Human Rights Campaign. In this position Donna has spearheaded a program to build the movement from the grassroots up. She directs a staff including three full-time field organizers who coordinate a network of more than 150 HRC activists. From 1989-1993, during two seasons of ballot measure attacks, Donna served as Executive Director of the Lesbian Community Project here in Portland. She became well-known for her inspirational speaking style, her willingness to engage in dialog and build bridges with many non-queer organizations including the Portland Police, and her fierce commitment to the whole lesbian, gay, bi, trans community. From 1993-1996 Donna was a senior consultant to the Gay & Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation (GLAAD), creating a grassroots network to monitor and respond to media representations of gay men, lesbians, bisexuals, and the transgendered community. Currently she lives in Washington, D.C., with her partner of ten years, Sumitra, though they still consider Portland to be their real home.



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
