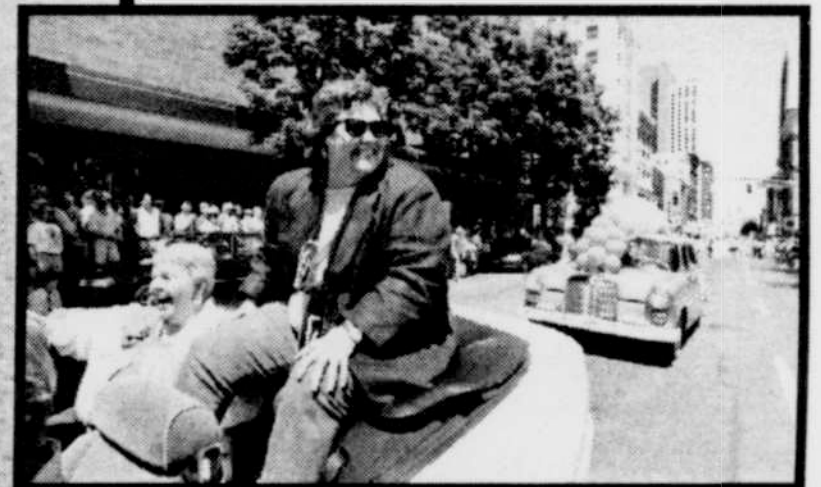

"But we got that ironed out," says MacAuslan.

As for the two-day format—as opposed to the more typical one-day affair—she says turnout was solid: "We had 2,500 people turn out for the [Saturday night] pride dance on the plaza, and we made our expenses on the beer garden on Saturday, so Sunday was just icing on the cake.... I think this was the best pride ever."
