It's tax time, and this traditionally unpleasant task can become a convenient way for folks to contribute to the fight against HIV and AIDS.

As in years past, Oregonians have the option of donating a portion of their tax refund for HIV and AIDS services administered by the AIDS Research & Education Group, a nonprofit, HIV-community-based research organization. The group estimates roughly \$100,000 is raised each year for HIV and AIDS services through the tax form check-off box.

In past years, the funds have been used as grants for organizations delivering care and services to people living with HIV and AIDS. Also benefiting are organizations providing education to prevent the spread of the disease and to support HIV research (community-based clinical trials) in Oregon.

Organizations bolstered by the funds over the years include OnTrack Inc. of Medford, HIV Alliance of Eugene, South Coast Health Council of Coos Bay, the Urban League of Portland and the Oregon Council for Hispanic Advancement. Other past recipients include Counterbal-

ance, a McMinnville-based support group for queer youth; and Outside In, which has received support for Gorilla Theater, an HIV prevention theater company by and for Portland's homeless youth.
