### **Help Get the Word Out.**

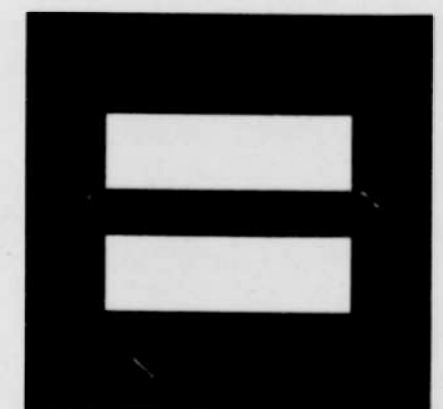
We can win, but only if all of us do our part. Everyone who cares about fairness and tolerance must take action. Together, united, we can defeat Measure 9.
