In the Salem proposal, "gender identity" is defined as a person's identity, expression or physical characteristics, whether or not traditionally associated with one's biological sex or one's sex at birth, including transsexual, transvestite and transgendered, and including a person's attitudes, preferences, beliefs and practices pertaining thereto.

#### LARGE COMPANIES SAY NO TO SCOUTS

Tells Fargo Bank and Portland General Electric both have decided to restrict the money they donate to the local United Way, the Oregonian reports. Both corporations, which annually donate hundreds of thousands of dollars to the nonprofit, say they don't want their employees' contributions to go to the Boy Scouts of America because it discriminates against gays.

Later, Wells Fargo clarified that it continues to support some Scout programs. The bank reported that it received many calls from customers threatening to close their accounts in protest of the decision to restrict its donations.

The United Way of the Columbia-Willamette came under fire in October when its board of directors made policy decisions that ultimately allowed continued funding of the Boy Scouts of America Cascade Pacific Council. Although the nonprofit says it opposes discrimination and urges its partner agencies to adhere to nondiscrimination policies, it doesn't require agencies receiving financial support to have such policies.

The decision by Wells Fargo and PGE didn't faze local Scouts.

"Our values aren't for sale," executive director Larry Otto told the Oregonian. "We aren't going to be trumped by anyone's dollars."

After a two-week stint at Providence Hospital, Shepherd is at home, where she receives physical, occupational and speech therapy five days a week. Her family reports that her dog is extremely happy to have her home.
