ing how many residents statewide would prefer to have their money benefit the civil rights movement rather than their own pocketbooks. This will send an especially clear message to "an administration that already has proven itself hostile to those very rights," executive director Roey Thorpe says.

BRO also is providing cards for donors reading: "Thank you, President Bush, for this opportunity to contribute to equal rights for all Americans, regardless of sexual orientation and gender identity. I have donated my tax refund to the struggle for these rights."

KEEPING THE FAITH

Perhaps President Bush's faith-based agenda isn't all that bad after all. If one takes a "glass is half-full" approach, the proposal seems to be taking attention away from anti-gay efforts.

A survey on the Christian Coalition of Oregon's Internet site asks visitors to vote on the right-wing organization's No. 1 priority. As of Aug. 1, faith-based initiatives topped the chart with 33 percent; "homosexuality in schools" came in second with 27 percent. Abortion (25 percent) and Boy Scouts (15 percent) rounded out the list. [E]
