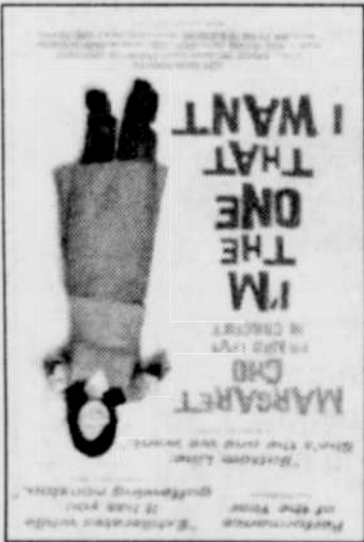

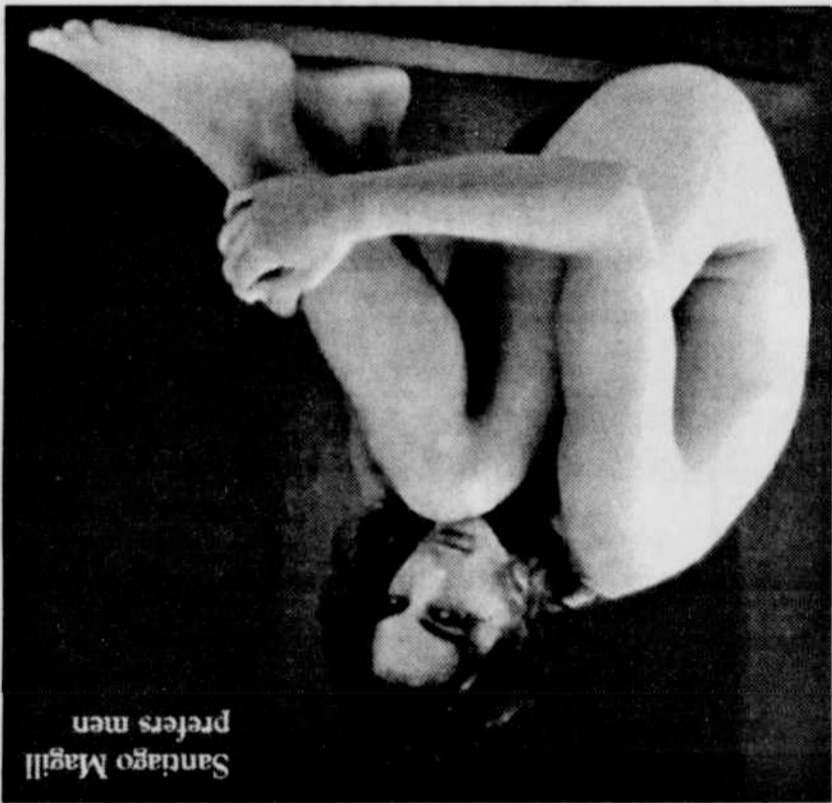


I'M THE ONE THAT I WANT

W hat a great idea! Collect 19 Broadway performers (many of course, are queertastic—Lea Delaria, Alan Cumming, Sam Harris), add gay icon Liza Minnelli for good measure, then have them record their favorite holiday songs.

And it's all to benefit Broadway Cares/Equity Fights AIDS.

Of the 16 cuts, 10 are decidedly Christmas songs, but the others are not holiday-specific, including "Baby It's Cold Outside," sung by Minnelli and Cumming, and "Sleigh Ride," which is given a jazzy interpretation by Delaria.

One of the fun features of *Home for the Holidays* is the booklet, which contains photos of all the celebs plus their thoughts on this holiday season. Not surprisingly, because these are mostly New Yorkers, patriotism is a strong

theme. But sassy Delaria probably isn't kidding when she writes, "What I want for Christmas is for Angelina Jolie to let me stuff her stockings."
Harris does a sinky, sexy rendition of "Merry Christmas Darling," and Patrick Wilson performs one of the best holiday songs from a musical, "We Need a Little Christmas." In *Mame*, of course, it's not sung in December, which brings home the point that sometimes you need the holiday spirit in April or July.
"Christmas Time Is Here" is given a soulful spin by the talented Billy Porter. But I believe the producers did save the best for last: Audra McDonald unleashing her awesome pipes on "White Christmas." Even Bing would have to beam.
