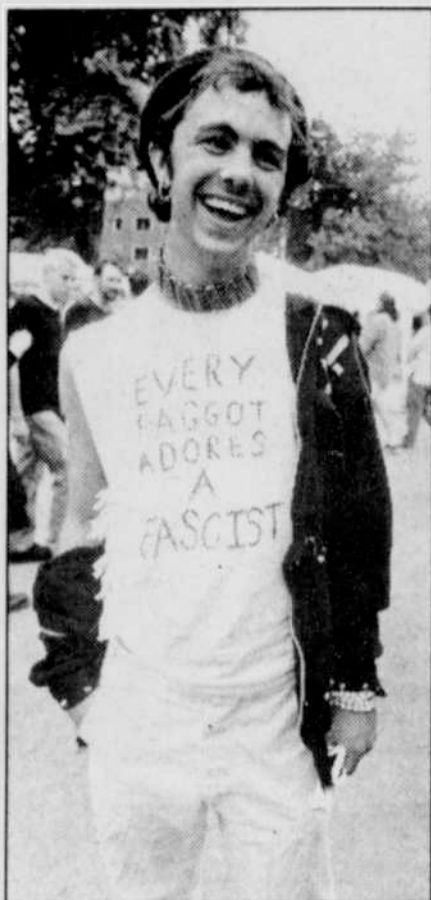


# On a queer day...
