Crude, rude and outrageous, two landmarks of gay cinema return to the big screen thanks to filmmakers David Weissman and Bill Weber, who dug up the long-lost masters for these underground masterpieces during their research for *The Cockettes*. Now the pristine video dubs they created give us a chance to relive one of the great eras of San Francisco's queer history and to enjoy the subversive antics of some of the wackiest divas to ever strut their stuff across the silver screen.

Tricia's Wedding takes aim at all of the smug conventions of the Nixon era with a mercilessly hilarious lampoon of Tricia Nixon's White House wedding. Rose Kennedy (Pristine Condition) can't remember if she's at a wedding or a funeral. Coretta Scott King (Sylvester) warbles an unlikely hymn. But things really take off when Anton Dunning as Eartha Kitt-- one of the most famous moments in the history of underground film--spikes the punch with LSD.



Elevator Girls In Bondage ups the ante by taking on not just the Republicans but the entire capitalist system and its oppression of the working class. The underpaid staff of a seedy hotel rises up in revolt, and by the time head elevator girl Maxine (the fabulous Rumi) starts spouting a surreal mix of folk songs and Marxist maxims, followed by an uproariously explicit sex scene, you'll be ready to join the cause. Rarely has the dissection of economic exploitation been so silly, or so much fun to watch.
