Bill Bradbury has a long-standing commitment to the Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgendered community which goes beyond election year politics. Throughout his career, he has proudly stood up against anti-gay ballot measures and legislation, and fought to protect the GLBT community from discrimination.

Bradbury: Worked to end discrimination in every sector of society. "Sexual orientation is a personal liberty and should never be a factor in access to housing, public facilities or economic and occupational opportunities. I have consistently fought to eliminate such discrimination practices and I will not stop fighting until such barriers are removed."

Smith: Maintained barriers against gays and lesbians. In the State Senate, Smith voted against a bill that would have outlawed discrimination in employment, housing and public accommodations on the basis of sexual orientation, stating it would erode "traditional family values." In the U.S. Senate, Smith voted to allow groups that exclude homosexual membership to meet in public facilities. Smith also refused in 1997 to endorse a bill that would outlaw discrimination in employment for gays and lesbians and refused to voluntarily adopt a policy of non-discrimination for his own Senate office.

Bradbury: Worked to defeat every anti-gay measure on Oregon's ballot, and proudly accepted the endorsement of Basic Rights Oregon. "I am honored to have the endorsement of Basic Rights Oregon; their continued fight to achieve social equality at every level should inspire all of us to work harder to put an end to discrimination. I've worked for the defeat of every anti-gay measure on Oregon's ballot, and I will continue to be there each and every time anyone challenges the rights of the LGBT communities."

Smith: Aligned with groups that work against the GLBT community and legislative agenda. Smith was endorsed by the Oregon Citizens Alliance, the group that sponsored all of Oregon's anti-gay ballot measures, in his first U.S. Senate race, and last year his PAC "Impact Oregon, Inc." donated \$1000 to the Christian Coalition. In Smith's first 4 years as a U.S. Senator he received an average of 45% in the Human Rights Campaign's congressional score card, and even refused to have a non-discrimination policy in his own Senate office.
