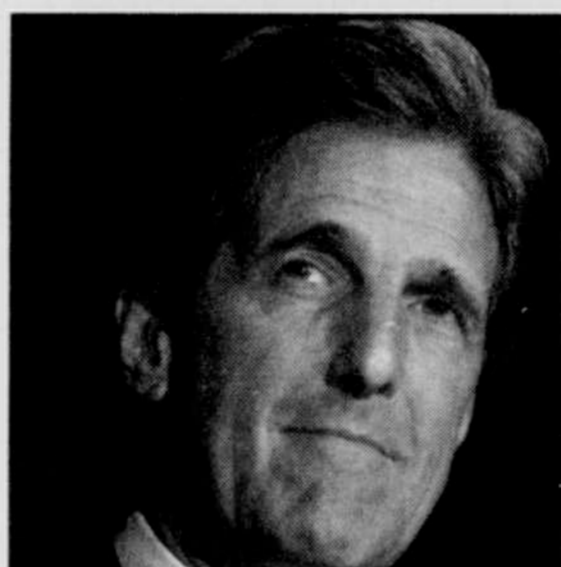
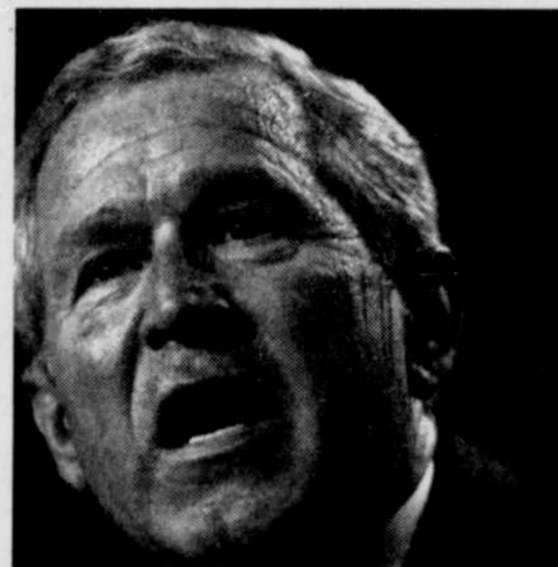

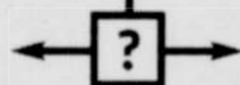

Federal Marriage Amendment

Opposes the FMA and any attempt to amend the U.S. Constitution to deny rights to GLBT persons and same-sex couples.

Workplace Fairness

Co-sponsored the Employment Non-Discrimination Act. Voted for it in 1996.

Hate Crimes

Voted for and is co-sponsor of the Local Law Enforcement Enhancement Act.

Fighting HIV/AIDS

Co-sponsor of Early Treatment for HIV Act. Supports full funding for science-based HIV-prevention programs and Ryan White CARE Act.

Federal Marriage Amendment

Supports the FMA. Publicly endorsed the discriminatory amendment in February 2004.

Workplace Fairness

Has never supported the Employment Non-Discrimination Act.

Hate Crimes

Opposes the Local Law Enforcement Enhancement Act. As governor, he blocked adding sexual orientation to the Texas hate crimes law.

Fighting HIV/AIDS

Has failed to advocate for the needed increases in federal spending for HIV prevention and care and treatment of people with HIV/AIDS.
