IN VANCOUVER...

A candlelight vigil will highlight Clark County's annual commemoration 7 p.m. at First United Congregational Church, 1220 N.E. 68th St. The ASL-interpreted event is free and open to all.

According to the Washington Department of Health, the number of cases of HIV infection in women statewide has doubled since the onset of the epidemic.

Invited speakers for this year's observance are gay state Rep. Jim Moeller, D-Vancouver, and Liz Luce, Southwest Washington director for the office of U.S. Sen. Maria Cantwell, D-Wash. Additional speakers will address the impact of HIV/AIDS infection on their own families and the community at large. Gospel singer Bishop Frank Martin and the Martin Temple Youth Choir will provide musical entertainment.

IN EUGENE...

The University of Oregon Cultural Forum will present a multimedia, site-specific installation by Eugene gay artist Mike E. Walsh. The installation, *Concourse Passage*, will be displayed along the full length of the Erb Memorial Union Concourse from 7 a.m. to 11:30 p.m.

Concourse Passage consists of two parallel rows of 23 white venetian blind slat markers adorned with the names of 46 people who have died of AIDS-related illnesses. On the floor beneath each slat, Walsh symbolically deconstructs the human body into rock-salt piles and bowls of blood-red liquid.

Oregon Public Broadcasting will profile Walsh on *Oregon Art Beat* at 6 p.m. Nov. 21.
