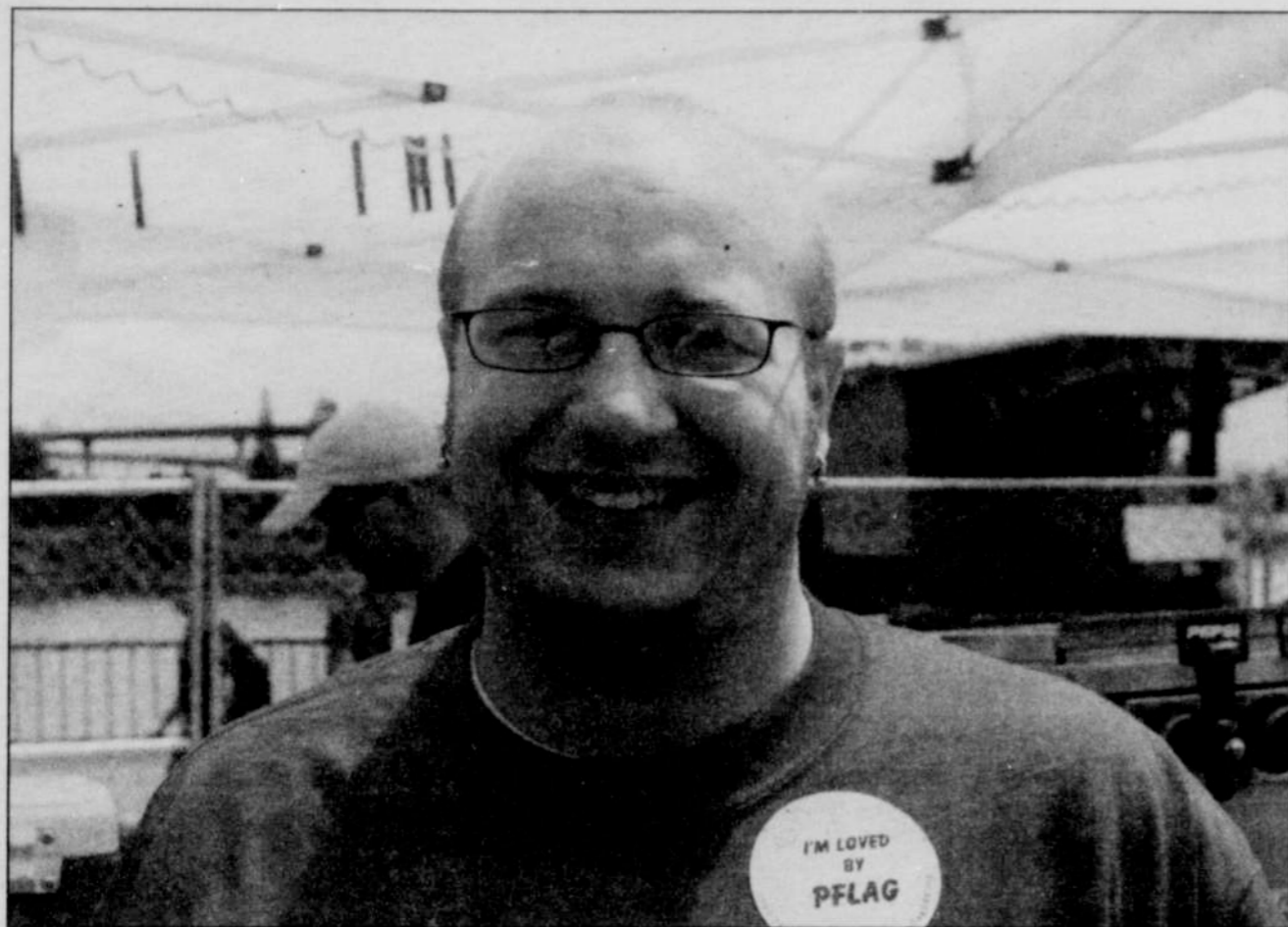

The Pride of the Rose Scholarship, administered through Equity Foundation and led by Frank Schreckenberger, Allison Grey, Scotly Devore Fox and Lotta Marie Liquor, is having a successful 26th year. Scholarship applications are being accepted until July 31.
