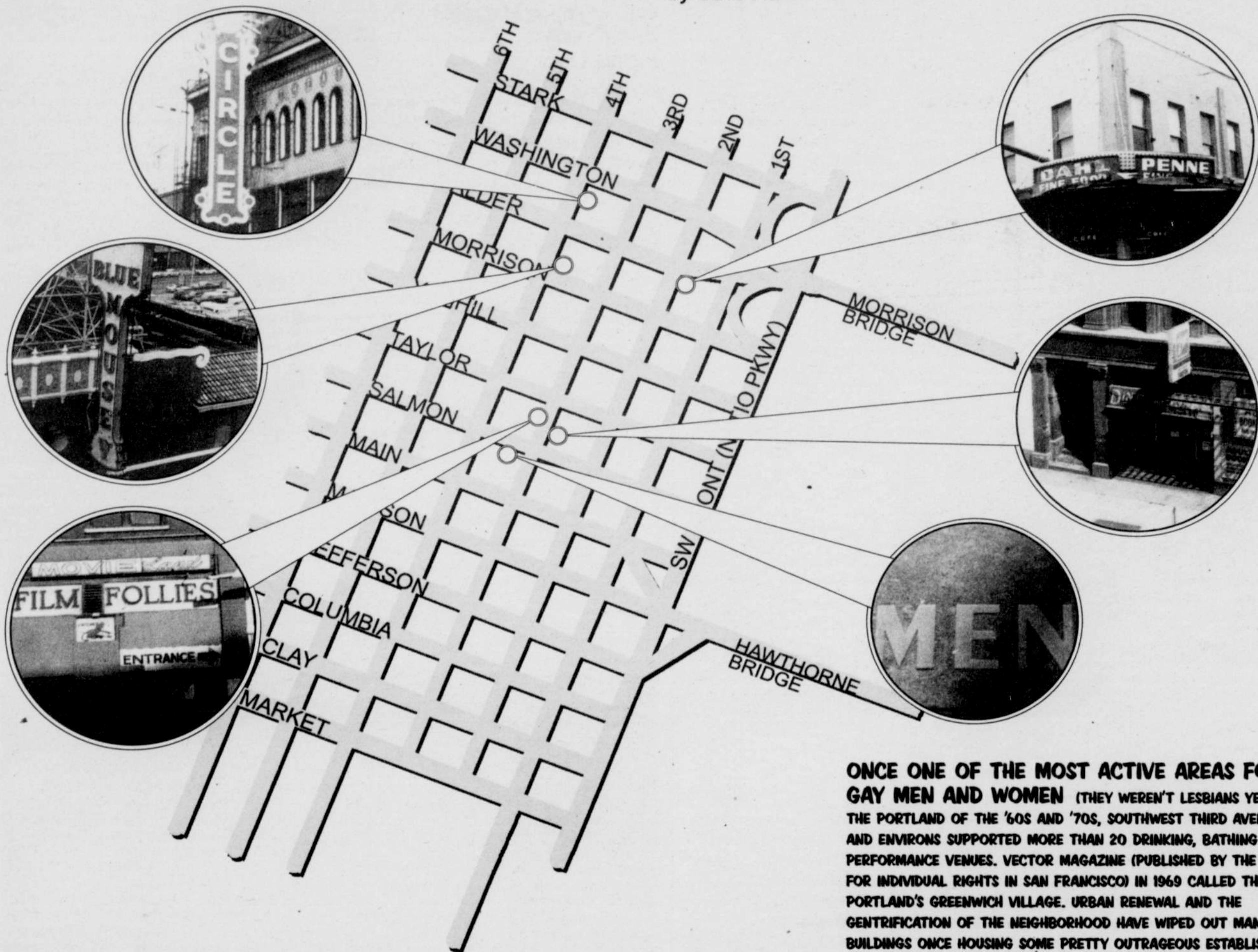


# HIKING "THE CAMP"
