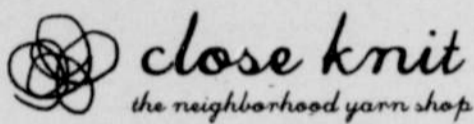

Jeung has been a chef for 25 years. "I come from a family where we all had to learn how to cook," he says. "I find it very relaxing."

**No Two Ways About It**

Same-sex couples in Hamilton, Ontario, were gearing up to celebrate Pride on June 6. On the same day, a few of these couples were informed they would now be legally registered parents of their children.

Melissa Rutherford, who grew up in McMinnville, and her partner, Melanie Parish, became involved in the class-action suit while Parish was still pregnant with Rutherford's fertilized ova. According to Rutherford, they were given the birth certificates for their 15-month-old twin sons, Emerson and Xander, about a year ago because the couple are both biological parents.

"The ruling recently came down in favor of the other three couples," said Rutherford. "Not having a legal connection to your kids leaves you vulnerable in a lot of different ways.

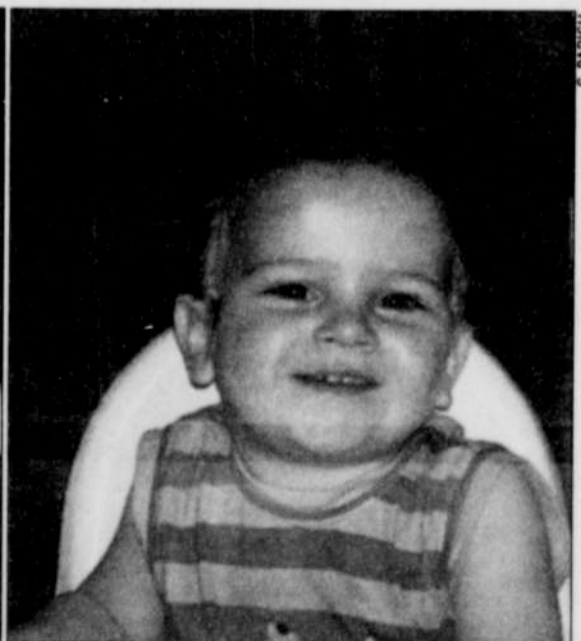
"Since we're both American citizens," adds

Rutherford, "they'll both be citizens, too, and we'll have to go through this all over again."

According to Rutherford, the U.S. consulate has refused to put both her and Parish on the paperwork necessary to attain the boys' U.S. birth certificates.

"Ironically, Ontario would have put Melanie as the mother and me as nothing, while the U.S. would put me as the mother following the genetic connection," said Rutherford. "And since our marriage isn't recognized by the U.S., the consulate says I'm an unwed mother!"

Ontario's Vital Statistics Act is the set of regulations that govern how the particulars about parents and the birth itself are recorded. "It screened out same-sex couples," said Rutherford. "It did not screen heterosexual couples who may have used a donor or a surrogate." Based on this
