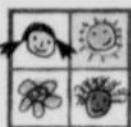

Providing opportunities for children to succeed and thrive in their homes, schools and communities through programs in:

- **EARLY CHILDHOOD:** early education and child development support through Head Start, child care and parenting education.
- **AFTER-SCHOOL and MENTORING:** constructive after-school activities ranging from academics to the arts and contact with positive adult and peer role models.
- **CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION and INTERVENTION:** support and intervention services such as counseling, education and respite care for families most at risk for abuse and neglect.

2005-2006 Program Highlights

- ✓ 10,000 children ages birth through 18 were helped through 66 programs.
- ✓ Young children gained the skills to succeed in kindergarten and beyond.
- ✓ Moms and Dads received support through outreach and parent education classes.
- ✓ Students at 70 schools throughout Portland improved in academics, attendance and behavior.
- ✓ Families saw an increase in stability and a reduction in violence and abuse.
- ✓ Matching grants brought an additional \$2.5 million in private investments to Portland's children.
- ✓ Fund administrative costs kept to 5 percent so 95 cents of every dollar went to Portland's children.

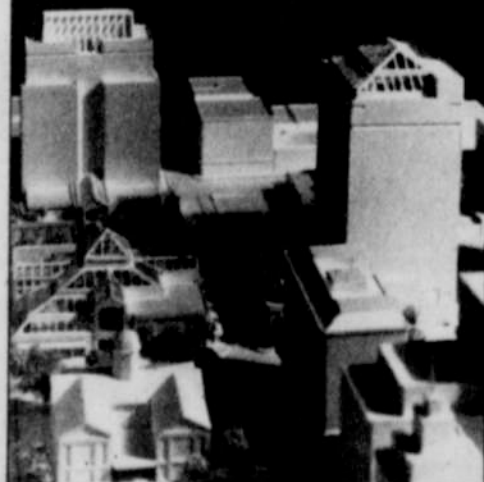


Through the support of a five-year tax levy passed by Portland voters in 2002, the Fund annually generates about \$10 million for Portland children.

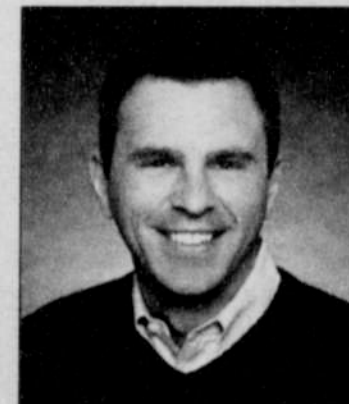

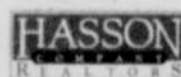
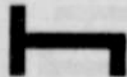
