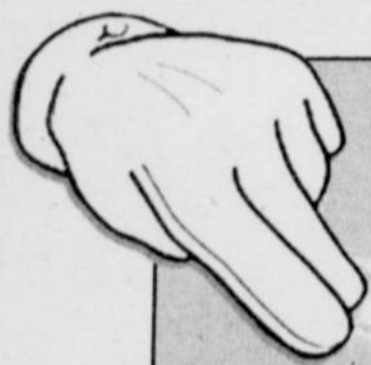

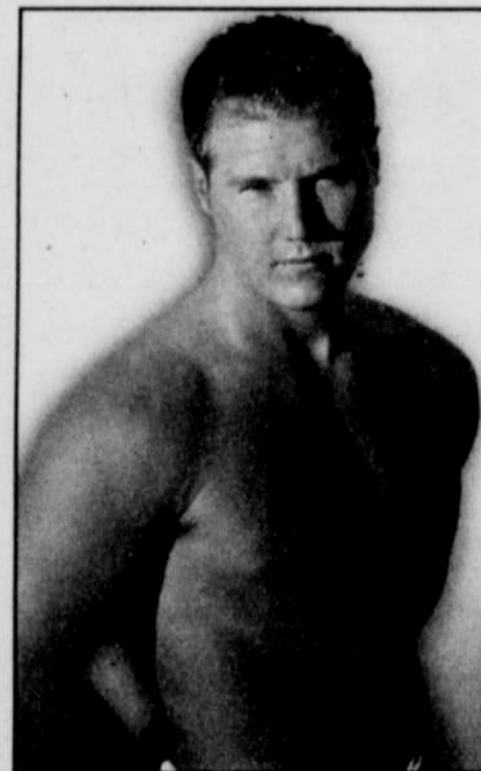

### Benefit Concert Planned

Kermie Wohlenhaus believes in angels. The angelologist, who developed breast cancer in March, found a few heavenly bodies here on earth to help with medical bills. Her friends and colleagues at Healing Waters & Sacred Spaces have planned a fund-raiser, An Evening of Angel Music. The concert will feature both popular and original songs about angels. Wohlenhaus will possibly air her angel meditation CD, which she says teaches people how to talk to their angels. Wohlenhaus, who described herself as "bald as a light bulb," underwent a lumpectomy and began radiation this month. She has completed four cycles of chemotherapy.

She describes the treatment as "kind of barbarian, but it's the best we have."

"Know that you're dealing with a fatal illness, so you should do whatever you can to get rid of it," she said.

That harsh treatment has turned Wohlenhaus to Quest Center for Integrative Health, which provides alternative care, including nutritional classes specifically for women in treatment, acupuncture, psychotherapy and hypnotherapy. Wohlenhaus only recently returned to her work giving angel readings at Healing Waters & Sacred Spaces.

Her partner, the Rev. Glenna Shepherd, who served more than three years as senior pastor of Metropolitan Community Church of Portland, relocated to England after she was affirmed by election to serve as an elder in Europe. Wohlenhaus has been living out of a suitcase at Peace House, run by the United Methodist Spiritual Community. She anxiously awaits joining Shepherd on Sept. 15.

The benefit concert is from 7 to 9 p.m. July 28 at MCC Portland, 2400 N.E. Broadway. Donations are gladly accepted.

### Gripp's Killer Sentenced

A year after a domestic dispute ended in death, Timmy Gripp's friends and relatives crammed into a Multnomah County Circuit Court room July 16 to witness the sentencing of his attacker and former boyfriend, Jeffery Scott Rogers.

Gripp, 50, and Rogers, 37, lived together on Southeast Hawthorne Boulevard near the Space Room, where both were regulars and where Gripp was last seen alive. Around 3 a.m. July 13, 2006, Rogers approached police at Central Precinct and led them to Gripp's body, which was in the bathtub at the home the couple shared, packed in ice and frozen food. No one knows exactly how long the

body had been there, but according to Detective John Rhodes, it could have been days. Strangulation and blunt force abdominal trauma were listed as the cause of death.

Rogers pleaded no contest to first-degree manslaughter, and Judge Eric Bergstrom sentenced him to 22 1/2 years. Rogers did not speak during the hearing, although many of Gripp's friends and family took the opportunity to remember the victim as a peaceful man with a gift for music and entertaining.

Gripp and Rogers had a history of domestic abuse, with at least one incident on record with the Portland Police Bureau. Resources for gay men who are victims of domestic violence are still limited in Portland. Although men have no emergency shelter options, they can call the Bradley-Angle House crisis line at 503-281-2442 or the national Gay Men's Domestic Violence Hotline at 800-832-1901.

### Judge Rules for Same-Sex Parents

The first of three cases filed to bring the state into compliance with the Oregon Supreme Court's 1998 ruling in Tanner v. OHSU landed in favor of equal rights for same-sex parents July 16.

The Tanner decision, a landmark victory for gay civil rights, found that assigning benefits based on marriage, while not permitting same-sex couples access to these benefits, constituted discrimination against certain families.
