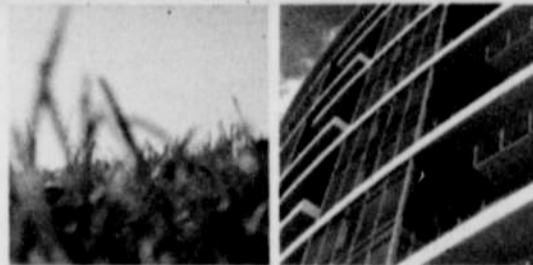

"We recorded our first record when we were 17 and 18. Our lives have developed. We've toured around the world, had out relationships. We've grown. Our playing has gotten a lot stronger. This one definitely feels it's more mature work—and much more of us," says Tegan, on behalf of them both.
